Chapter 2: Appearance

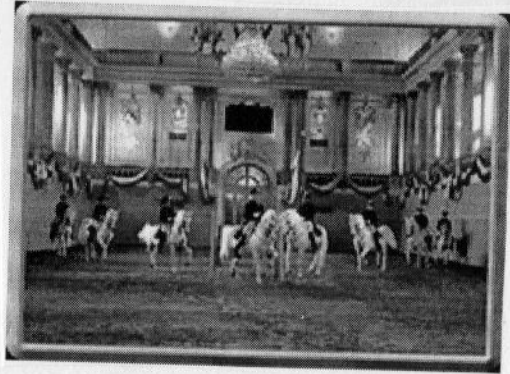

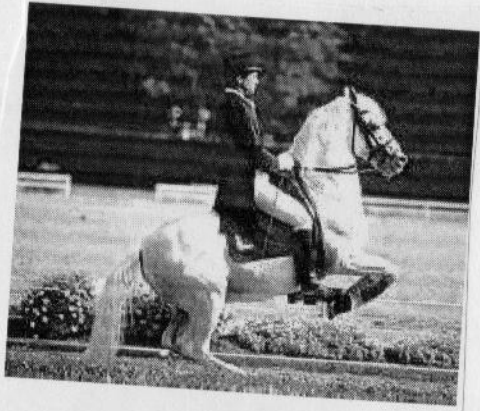
Chapter 3: History

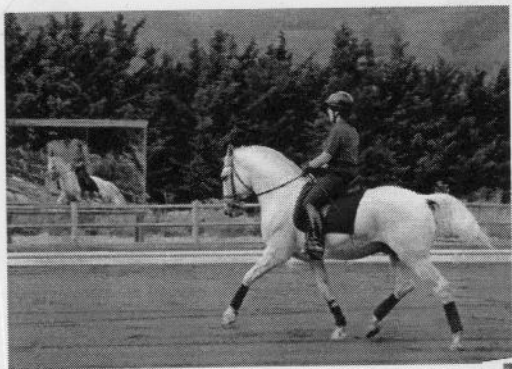
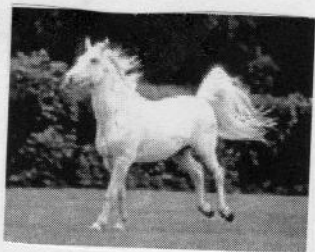
